Quality Assurance

All quality assurance will run from 6~7:30 pm at the Mahan Building.

You must pre-register (call the office), available dates: May 10th and May 17th

All market animal exhibitors must complete one QA for 2021.

ALL QA MUST BE COMPLETE BY JUNE 4, 2021.

We are pre-registering kids for QA to abide by COVID-19 precautions and social distancing.

Masks will be required. FFA members (8th grade included) generally get their certification through class and if members attended a program outside of the county, they must provide a certificate of completion. If kids decide to complete the online YQCA we accept that for kids 12 and older. If it was completed after October of 2020 it will count towards their 2021 QA requirement.

FairEntry (Pen Assignments)

FairEntry will Open: April 12th Closes: June 11th with late entries (\$25 fee) June 18th

All animals (individually, unless shown as a pen) must be entered within this system to show at the fair. Showmanship will be signed up for in the barns.

Club/Meeting Information

In-person Meetings and Events Guidance and Requirements

Beginning SATURDAY, JANUARY 16, 2021, the following is in effect:

- Hosting virtual meetings and events is preferred
- If activities are critical/essential and are in-person, they must be education-focused
- Group cannot be larger than 50 people, including adults, youth, presenters, etc.
- This directive is dependent on local health department guidelines.
- The group size may need to be reduced to 10 (or other amount), based on directives from your local health department.
- Face masks are required inside and outside at all times
- Potlucks and buffets are not permitted
