## Book Checks

**Opens June 1.** Youth must be present with their project book when being checked. This is for youth who have tested out of skillathons. They must be completed by July 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. Prior to skillathons, book checks are done in the office.

## **ONLINE Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF)**

Link will be shared one week prior to the fair to begin completion. DUNFs must be completed prior to crossing the scales at check-in.

## **Instructions**

General Rule (Page 66 of 2022 Fayette County Jr. Fair Rule Book) states:

All Junior Fair market exhibitors must complete an Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) Drug Use Notification Form to be eligible to exhibit and/or sell at the Fayette County Junior Fair for each market livestock project. Completed Drug Use Notification Forms must be turned in when the exhibitor's market animal is weighed at the Junior Fair weigh-in.

The following species must complete a separate DUNF for **each animal**:

- Dairy Feeders
- Beef Feeders
- Market Dairy Beef
- Market Beef
- Market Hogs
- Market Lambs
- Market Goats
- Market Turkey
- Market Pen of Chickens (1 DUNF per pen of Chickens)

Market Rabbits DO NOT need to complete the DUNF.

## How to Properly Address an Envelope

All Thank You Notes are due to the Mahan Building by Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm



Front of Envelope

1. Your **RETURN ADDRESS** here—include your name & address
2. Place first-class **STAMP** here
3. Write **BUYER'S ADDRESS** here—include buyer's name, company name (if applicable), and complete address

### Other Envelope notes:

- Write neatly!!
- Use blue or black ink pen to address envelope (or print address label)
- Address the envelope properly using the example above
- Seal the envelope once the Thank You card is written and placed inside the envelope

## How to Write a Thank You Note



Inside of Card

1. The **GREETING** starts with "Dear" and the Buyer's name and/or Company name followed by a comma
2. Write the **BODY** of your card—include 4-6 sentences; you can include why you are thanking them, a little about your project, something you learned this year, thanking them for supporting our 4-H & FFA programs and our Fair, thanking them for purchasing your animal, etc.
3. The **CLOSING** can be as simple as "Thank You," or "Sincerely,"—be sure to sign your first and last name

### Other Thank You Card notes:

- Write neatly!! Practice on a scratch piece of paper first if you need to!
- Use ink to write your Thank You card—you can use colored ink if you want, but make sure it is easy to see & read

All Jr. Fair Livestock exhibitors whose livestock goes through the Sale are required to write a Thank You note to each buyer. The following are guidelines to help you prepare your Thank You note.

- Write neatly & use blue or black ink to write your Thank You card & envelope!! Practice on a scratch piece of paper first if you need to!
- You can use any kind of Thank You card as long as it is appropriate to send to your buyer(s)—you can purchase it, make your own, include a picture of you with your animal at the Fair, etc.
- Contact your 4-H or FFA Advisor if you have any questions
- A list of Sale Buyers will be posted on the 4-H webpage and will include the names and addresses of all Buyers
