Project Judging Guidelines

Fair Booths

Theme is "Rippin at the Fayette County Fair"

Advisor will contact youth about 4-H Booth decorating/set-up in the Youth Building Dates: Saturday, July 15, 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

All booths will be judged for development around theme, ability to attract attention, neatness, originality, members involved in set-up, display of projects and names of the advisors and club members (can be first name only).

Booths may be dismantled, items removed between 12:00 noon and 2:00 pm on Saturday July 22. Exhibits may not be removed earlier. Any items left in booth after 2:00 pm will become the property of the Fayette County Agricultural Society. Miscellaneous projects should be picked up before noon. No supervision will be available.

Projects are displayed at own risk of damage or destruction.

To sign up for a fair booth call the Fayette County Extension office (740-335-1150) before deadline June 23 and sign up for whole or half booth.

ONLINE Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF)

Link will be shared July 3^{rd,} prior to the fair to begin completion. DUNFs must be completed prior to crossing the scales at check-in.

Instructions

General Rule (Page 69 of 2023 Fayette County Jr. Fair Rule Book) states: All Junior Fair market exhibitors must complete an Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) Drug Use Notification Form to be eligible to exhibit and/or sell at the Fayette County Junior Fair for each market livestock project. Completed Drug Use Notification Forms must be turned in when the exhibitor's market animal is weighed at the Junior Fair weigh-in.

The following species must complete a separate DUNF for **each animal**:

- Dairy Feeders
- Beef Feeders
- Market Dairy Beef
- Market Beef
- Market Hogs
- Market Lambs
- Market Goats
- Market Turkey
- Market Pen of Chickens (1 DUNF per pen of Chickens)
- <u>NEW</u> Market Pen of Rabbits (1 DUNF per pen of Rabbits)

(Poultry projects type N/A for identification, it will be added by Fair Staff after weigh-in)


Front of Envelope

- 1. Your RETURN ADDRESS here—include your name & address
- 2. Place first-class STAMP here
- 3. Write BUYER'S ADDRESS here—include buyer's name, company name (if applicable), and complete address

Other Envelope notes:

- Write neatly!!
- Use blue or black ink pen to address envelope (or print address label)
- Address the envelope properly using the example above
- Seal the envelope once the Thank You card is written and placed inside the envelope

How to Write a Thank You Note



Thank you for purchasing my 4-H market hog. I have been showing market hogs since I was 9 years old. I also have turkeys that I raise for my FFA project. This year I tried Swine Showmanship for the first time. I wasn't in the top 5, but I think I did pretty good for my first

Thank you for supporting our Jr. Fair livestock projects, and I hope you will join us at next year's fair, too.

Thank you,

1. The GREETING starts with "Dear" and the Buyer's name and/or Company name followed by a comma

Inside of Card

- 2. Write the BODY of your card—include 4-6 sentences; you can include why you are thanking them, a little about your project, something you learned this year, thanking them for supporting our 4-H & FFA programs and our Fair, thanking them for purchasing your animal, etc.
- 3. The CLOSING can be as simple as "Thank You," or "Sincerely,"—be sure to sign your first and last name

Other Thank You Card notes:

- · Write neatly!! Practice on a scratch piece of paper first if you need to!
- Use ink to write your Thank You card—you can use colored ink if you want, but make sure it is easy to see & read





All Jr. Fair Livestock exhibitors whose livestock goes through the Sale are required to write a Thank You note to each buyer. The following are guidelines to help you prepare your Thank You note.

- •Write neatly & use blue or black ink to write your Thank You card & envelope!! Practice on a scratch piece of paper first if you need to!
- You can use any kind of Thank You card as long as it is appropriate to send to your buyer(s)—you can purchase it, make your own, include a picture of you with your animal at the Fair, etc.
- Contact your 4-H or FFA Advisor if you have any questions
- •A list of Sale Buyers will be posted on the 4-H webpage and will include the names and addresses of all Buyers
