- ❖ Improves animals' health and well being
- ❖ Reduce the risk of Zoonotic Diseases
- ❖ Post emergency numbers in the barn

## To properly store and administer animal health products **GPP: 4**

- ❖ Everyone is responsible for how to properly administer animal health products.
- ❖ Know how to read a medication label
- ❖ Withdrawal times
- ❖ Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF)
- ❖ Proper medication storage
- ❖ Keep Accurate Records
- ❖ Oral, Topical, Injections
  - ❖ Subcutaneous Injection (SQ)
  - ❖ Intramuscular Injection (IM)
  - ❖ Intra-articular
  - ❖ Intravenous
- ❖ Always check your needles

## **GPP: 5** To follow feed processing protocols.

- ❖ Medicated Feed
  - ❖ Can not be fed extra label
- ❖ Prevent Cross contamination
- ❖ Know how to read a feed label
- ❖ Proper feed storage
  - ❖ Moisture and Temperature
