## Participants Eligibility

Application is open to all individuals 18 years and older regardless of race, creed, gender, disability or employment status. Applicants must have a stake in Fayette County, either as a resident or representative of a Fayette County-based business or organization.

## The Program Duration

The program spans eight months and includes leadership sessions from April through November. Leadership sessions typically require a commitment either in the evening or morning (Day and time TBA).
